Narrator: Oscar and Thomas are now at a museum in **Milan**. They are looking at the famous paintings... (Oscar & Thomas were looking around and at the painting.)

Thomas: Hi, Oscar. What are you doing here?

Oscar: Oh! Don't you know? (pointing to the painting) These famous paintings

were drawn by a famous painter?

Thomas: Leonardo da Vinci!! (pointing to the painter who is painting at the corner)

Oscar: He's over there...back to the 1490s...

Reporter: This is Leonardo da Vinci.

May I ask you a few questions about this picture?

Da Vinci: Sure. (keep painting)

Reporter: Can you tell us something about this picture?

Da Vinci: OK. The Last Supper is a big fresco. The painting represents the scene of The Last Supper, the final meal, of Jesus with his apostles. When Jesus said to his 12 disciples that one of them would betray him, everyone was surprised with different postures, signs and looks. My painting captures that scene. (point to the "real" 12 apostles.)

Reporter: Can you also explain the composition of the picture?

Da Vinci: Jesus is in the centre. I put the apostles into groups and I borrowed the edge of the ceiling and both sides of slopes. It makes the audience focus on Jesus.

Reporter: Thank you for your introduction of the picture. Let's take a closer look!

Narrator: Jesus was having the final meal with his disciples – Bartholomew, James,
Peter, Andrew, Judas, John, Thomas, James, Philip, Thaddeus, Matthew and
Simon. (Disciples stand up **one by one** as the narrator reads the names)

Jesus: Tonight is the last dinner for us!

Thaddeus: Why?

Jesus: It is because one of you will betray me.

Peter: me?
Andrew: me?
John: me?
Philip: me?
James: me?
Simon: me?
Judas: me?

Jesus: It's you.

James: We can't lose you! Also, if we lose you, we will not have any power to help

people!

Jesus: No, you are wrong because all of you will inherit my thinking and spread it

to other people.

Narrator: Guess what Jesus is going to do for his apostles??

Jesus: Oh! Your feet are very dirty, so may I help to wash them?

James: Um...please don't because you are our leader.

Jesus: Unless I wash you, you have no part with me.

Narrator: Jesus finally finished washing their feet and they finished the last supper.

After Judas left, Jesus told his remaining eleven apostles that he will be with them for only a short time and he gave them a new command – As I have loved you, so you must love one another. Love each other as I have

loved you.

Thomas: I have just learnt the story in the painting drawn by Leonardo da Vinci.

Oscar: I want to find out more about his paintings. Let's go!
