教學語言安排

依教育局的指引,本校初中每級均有3班可以英語教授全部科目。

校本安排

- 本校為避免錯配中一新生和避免不必要的負面影響,決定中一各班的授課語言安排一樣。
- 唯同學升讀中二至中三時·編班時將按他們的英文科成績及以英語授課的科目的成績分班· 英語能力稍遜的同學將被編入「彈性班」;該班採小班教學模式·幫助同學強化英語能力。

英語教學措施

為提升學生英語能力及增潤校內學習英語的環境,本校推出不同措施支持英語的學與教。

課程和教學

- 為升讀本校的小六學生提供暑期英語銜接課程,教授中學各科的英文用詞和用語, 有助掌握以英語學習不同科目的技巧。
- 開學後·各以英語授課的科目均有系統地幫助學生熟習該科的慣常英文用語· 教學進度亦會因應學生的學習表現而調整。
- 中一、二、四、五及六級的英文科設小班教學,讓學生學得更好。
- 外籍教師於中一至三級各班教授英語會話。
- 英文科教師與其他學科教師協作,促進學生有效地運用英語學習。
- 為鼓勵學生廣泛閱讀,本校設有早會閱讀,並在班中作閱讀分享。
- 學生須訂閱英文報章, 英文科教師會在課堂帶領閱讀及討論。
- 為全校學生設置網上英語自學平台,鼓勵學生自主學習。
- 為學生安排拔尖及增潤課程,以切合不同能力學生的需要。
- 與大專院校及教育局合作,為教師提供培訓,加強他們以英語授課的效能。

延伸課程

- 英文科及英文學會舉辦一系列活動,包括英語茶座、英語短講、電影欣賞、 英文歌曲點唱、參觀活動、英文話劇、英語同樂日、午間英語活動等。
- 除英文科外,亦有跨科英語日及活動。
- 於英文周舉辦不同的活動和遊戲。
- 為升讀本校的小六學生提供為期十天,由外籍英語導師指導的英語銜接課程。
- 提供機會讓學牛及英語大使在英語活動及營造英語環境方面擔當重要角色。

英語環境


- 主要學科及組別的壁報、成績榜及榮譽榜均以英文展示或中英並列。
- 校內大型活動和重要典禮,例如運動會、頒獎禮、開學禮等,均以英語進行。
- 半數早會由教師及學生以英語進行,早會並會邀請英語大使、各班代表、 學會幹事、不同科目的教師作英語分享或活動宣傳。
- 在校內不同地方展示英語海報。

其他支援措施

- 學生可借閱英語閣的跨科英語書籍,及圖書館的英文書籍。
- 開放多媒體學習中心, 鼓勵學生瀏覽網上教學資源或完成網上自學教材。
- 每年均以問卷調查學生對英文科教學及相關措施的意見·藉以優化英語的學與教。









Medium of Instruction (MOI) Policy

According to the Refined Medium of Instruction Policy issued by the Education Bureau, English can be used as the medium of instruction for all subjects in 3 out of 4 classes in F.1. F.2 and F.3.

School-based arrangement

Mathematics

- To avoid mismatching and negative labeling effect on Form one students, all Form one classes will adopt the same medium of instruction.
- In Form 2 and Form 3, there are 3 classes using English as the Medium of Instruction. When students are promoted to Form 2 or Form 3, their performance in English Language and subjects taught in English will be used to decide whether they are going to study in the 3 "English classes" or the "English enhancement class". The "English enhancement class" has a smaller class size of about 25 students so as to cater for learner diversity and better equip students for senior secondary education.

Measures to enhance students' English proficiency

Our school has adopted various measures to enhance students' English proficiency and to create an English-rich learning environment.

Curriculum and Teaching

- All Form one new intakes will have to attend an English bridging programme to get familiar with the vocabulary and phrases commonly used in subjects taught in English.
- Teachers teaching subjects adopting English as the MOI will familiarize students with vocabulary and expressions of the subjects concerned. They will also adjust the teaching pace according to students' learning.
- Small class teaching is implemented in Form 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6 English lessons so as to cater better for learner diversity.
- There are oral lessons with the NET for each class of Form 1 to 3.
- The school has set up a Language Across the Curriculum Unit in which English teachers and content subject teachers can collaborate to support students to learn in English.
- Students are encouraged to read extensively during morning reading session and to have book-sharing in class.
- Students have to subscribe to English newspapers and read in class under the guidance of teachers.
- To foster self-access learning, the school provides all students with an online English learning platform to boost independent learning.
- Enhancement and remedial English classes are offered to appropriate students.
- With the co-operation of local universities and the Education Bureau, the school provides ample teacher training to enhance teachers' teaching effectiveness when using English as the MOI.

Co-Curricular Activities

- The English Department and the English Club have organized various English activities, including English Café, movie shows, Radio Fantasia, English Speaking Days, English Drama, English Fun Day, English Stall Games, visits and outings.
- The English Department will also collaborate closely with other subject departments to organize activities which are conducive to learning.
- A 10-day summer English Bridging Programme run by English speaking tutors is organized for new Form 1 intakes so as to allow them to use English in a fun way.
- English Ambassadors and student leaders are encouraged to take up a leading role in organizing English activities and school events conducted in English.

Creating a Language-rich Environment

- English is adopted as the major medium for board displays.
- Major school events, such as Sports Days, the Opening Ceremony, the Prize Giving Ceremony, etc., are conducted in English.
- Morning assemblies are mainly conducted in English. Teachers of various subjects, student representatives from each class and various clubs will make announcements or promotions in English under the guidance of English teachers.
- Eye-catching English posters and banners bearing wholesome messages are displayed all around the school campus.

Other Supporting Measures

- Students can easily access and borrow English books of different subjects, from the school library and the English Corner.
- Students are encouraged to make use of the Multi-Media Learning Centre (MMLC) to get access to online learning materials.
- Surveys are conducted at least once every year to collect views about English learning and teaching.
