Melissa: Later, a Japanese company Nikoli introduce this game to Japan. It was so popular and it got a new name Sudoku!

Elaine: Right! Also, Sudoku has a lot of different methods. We can change the numbers to English letters , like A, B, C. We called iti forgot

Andy: 'Alphabetical Sudoku'.

Melissa: right! If you think it is boring, you can change the grid from 9 by 9 to 4 by 4 or 16 by 16.

Elaine: And we have Mini Sudoku, Cross Sums Sudoku and Killer Sudoku. They are all really fun.

Daniel: OH I know that...

Andy: So..lets play Sudoku~

Others: OK, that would be fun
