Class presentation

E: Hey, see what I found on the ground. It is an old silk hat. How about we

put it on the head of the snowman?

A,C,D,E Yes!

Narrator: Immediately after the hat is put on the snowman, the snowman is alive

and talks to the children.

Snowman: Hi, children. (Dancing)

All children: Wow!! (Scared)

Snowman: Please don't be afraid, I'm a kind hearted snowman. I will not hurt you.

Hm... Let's play. Catch me if you can.

All children: Yeah! ©

Narrator: The children chase after the snowman. They are so happy that they keep

on running, running and running until they meet a traffic policeman.

Police: Children and snowman, the traffic here is very busy. Stop running!

Children and snowman: Yes Sir.

Police: You may play in the WYY country park over there.

Children and snowman: Yes Sir. Thank you sir.

Narrator: The children and the snowman have a very happy morning, but soon when

the sun rises high in the sky

A: Snowman, you are melting! (Astonishing)

Other children: Melting!! (Astonishing)

Snowman: Yes, I am melting. And I am going to disappear very soon. (Calmly)

That's why I treasure very much the time with you all.

All Children: We love you. We don't want to lose you. (Crying)

Snowman: Don't be so sad. Everything has an end. But as long as we live our lives to
