Characters: Student A, B (Narrators)

Representatives of Britain, France, Italy, Soviet Union, United States, Germany, Poland

Mussolini and his Fascist Party

Hitler and his Nazi Party

Chinese, Japanese and Hong Kong

#### <u>Scenel</u>

(Rings) (student A and student B go on the stage)

Student A: It's finally the end of the History lesson! I should start to do my History homework. (flip through the homework)

Student A: Oh my goodness! Summary of the Second World War? I wish I had listened what Miss Wong said in the last lesson.....

Student B: Hey, (student A's name). What's up? Do you need any help?

Student A: I don't know how to do the History homework!

Student B: Let me help you.

Student A: Are you going to help me? (excited)

Student B: Of course not! But I can help summarize things happened in the Second World War.

(leave the stage) (Britain, France, Italy, Soviet Union, United States, Germany on stage)

## <u>Scene2</u>

Britain: I got in casualties and economic loss! I will do anything to avoid another war. France: Finally..... I succeeded in taking revenge. But I have to prevent Germany from being strong again.

Italy: I only received little compensation..... I have to get back what I deserve! Soviet Union: I won't attack but I will try to co-exist with others peacefully.

United States: I won't get involved among Europeans again.

Germany: (Holding a paper (written TREATY OR VERSAILLES)) The terms of the treaty are very harsh! I will be back...... I WILL BE BACK!!! (mad)

Student B: After understanding the international situation, let's talk about the rise of totalitarianism.

Student A: What is it?

Student B: Totalitarianism is a political system under a dictator. For examples, Benito Mussolini and Hitler were dictators.

(leave the stage) (Britain, France, Italy, Soviet Union, United States, Germany on stage)

<u>Scene3</u>

Student A: In 1919, Mussolini formed a political party.

(Mussolini and his Fascist Party on stage)

Mussolini: This is my Fascist Party! (point at the Fascist Party members)

Fascist Party members: Fascism! Fascism! FASCISM!!!!!!

Student A: In October 1922, Mussolini seized power and later declared himself the leader of Italy.

(Mussolini and his Fascist Party clap their hands and cheer. Then leave)

## <u>Scene4</u>

Student B: Hitler was a veteran of the First World War. He was a gifted speaker and a hero of the German people.

(Hitler and his Nazi Party on stage)

Nazi Party: Hitler, Hitler, HITLER!!!!!!

Student B: In 1921, he became the leader of the Nazi Party, and his political ideas were known as Nazism.

Nazi Party: Hitler, you are our savior! You are the only one who can save Germany and make us stronger again.

(Hitler shakes hand with Nazi Party)

(Hitler takes out the paper (Treaty of Versailles) and tears it)

Hitler: Go to die, you Jews!

Jews: NO!!!!!!

(Hitler kills them and leaves (some Germans carry the Jews.)

## <u>Scene5</u>

Student A: In 1939, the Second World War broke out. The Axis Powers, Italy, Germany and Japan invaded other countries. The Allied Powers were attacked.

(Chinese and Japanese on stage)

Japanese: We are killing all of you! (Point at Chinese)

Chinese: Oh no! (Trying to escape)

(Chinese leave like escaping, Japanese stay)

(United States on stage)

Student B: On 7 December 1941, Japan suddenly attacked the American naval base in Pearl Harbor.

Japanese: Attack!

United States: What?!

(United States leaves angrily)

(Hong Kong is on stage, Japanese stay)

Student A: On 25 December, Japan occupied Hong Kong.

Japanese: Yeah!

Hong Kong: Why..... (sadly)

(Japanese stay and HK leave)

Student A: Although the Axis Powers were powerful, the final victories belonged to the Allied Powers.

(United States on stage)

Student B: In 1944, the Allies took back Paris. In 1946, The United States dropped an atomic bomb on Hiroshima and Nagasaki respectively.

United States: Japan, you can't get away with my atomic bomb!

Japanese: Argh!!!!!!!!!

Student A: At last, on 15 August 1945, Japan declared unconditional surrender. The

Second World War ended.

(Japanese holding a white flag and leave)

(Student A and B on stage)

<u>Scene6</u>

Student B: That's the end of the Second World War.

Student A: What an important war!

Student B: Yes, the Second World War also influences the world. If you want to know more,

don't forget to pay attention in History class!

(All characters on stage)
