<p>News Reporter 3B9 Ho Hei Yin</p>	<p>According to a report by the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), published in May 2022, there is a 50:50 chance of average global temperature reaching 1.5 degrees Celcius above pre-industrial levels in the next five years, and the likelihood is increasing with time.</p> <p>A 1.5C rise is considered the threshold for dangerous climate change.</p> <p>Different countries are having international conference to combat the problem. More developed countries should contribute more and set higher targets for CO2 reduction. The more developed countries such as USA and Japan are also advised to offer subsidies to the less developed countries such as China and India so that they have more resources to improve their energy efficiency.</p> <p>MDCs1: Wait. Why do we have to pay more for less developed countries? That's none of our business.</p> <p>LDCs1: Because we're less developed countries, so we have less money. That's why...</p> <p>MDCs1: Do you know what you're saying? You are not poor anymore. And in recent years, guess who emits the greatest amount of CO2? It's you, LDCs! In the 19th century and 20th century, you emitted even more CO2 than we are emitting now. You also have greater responsibility to reduce cO2 emissions.</p> <p>MDCs2: We're talking about now, not past centuries.</p> <p>Chairman: (Slap the table) Enough! Our world is dying. Many people and species are suffering from the impacts of climate change.</p>
