Bach	I was born into a huge musical family.
Little Bach	(copying music) To learn music, I stayed up late every night copying scores by candlelight (holding a candle). My eyes were so tired!
(Background photo: church)	
Bach	I spent my life writing for churches and kings. I perfected "Polyphony"—that's when many melodies play together perfectly.
Angel A	(Holds a sign: The Well-Tempered Clavier) Mr. Bach also created the "12-tone system." This allows pianos to play in every key!
Bach	(Proudly) That is why people call me the "Father of Music."

Mozart's Story

(Background photo: **Europe**)

Mozart	I started composing at age 4! By age 6, I was touring all of Europe with my father. Kings and Queens loved me! (King/Queen clap hands/kiss Mozart)
Angel B	He was a true child prodigy! He could hear a song once and write it down perfectly.
(Background photo: theatre)	
Mozart	I made operas and concertos elegant and beautiful. Did you know I even wrote the variations for "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star"?
Angel B	(Reading from iPad, funny face) Mozart was a genius, but he was also a prankster! He once jumped on a table and meowed like a cat during a rehearsal!
Mozart	(Hands on Table, Twist his neck) Meow!!! Haha, life needs to be fun!

Beethoven	My life wasn't as easy as Mozart's. My father was very strict. He wanted me to be the next "Wonder Child."
Bee's dad	(Angry) Practice! Don't sleep until you get it right!
Beethoven	The worst part? I started losing my hearing when I was 20 years old.
(Show a photo: Beethoven's deaf photo)	
Beethoven	I couldn't hear the world, (hand on chest) but I could hear the rhythm in my heart! (Eyes closed) I put my deepest emotions into my music. (Eyes open) This started the "Romantic Era."
Angel C	Even when he was completely deaf, he wrote the Ninth Symphony. It is the greatest anthem for humanity!
