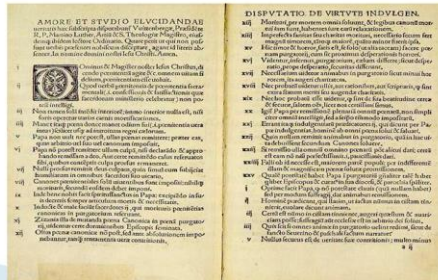
If your group could travel back in time to the Renaissance and you would meet Martin Luther...

The 95 Theses
(《九十五條論綱》)
written by Martin Luther (馬丁路德)

- Martin Luther wrote a list of 95 objections
- nailed the list to a church door
- This led to the Reformation in the 16th century.


