WYY English Department is launching the SuperVoice Singing Contest to boost students' English pronunciation, confidence, and performance skills through singing.

Target Participants: WYY students with exceptional voices and talents in singing **Format:**

- First Round (<u>Class-based Online First Take</u>): Each class appoints <u>one student/one group/whole class</u> to represent their class. The student(s) will sing an English song of his/her/their choice, which will be recorded for the First Round. This will involve anonymous online polling and judging.
- Online Polling: All WYY students and staff can vote for their favourite contestant(s) in each form via Google Polling. The class with the highest votes in each form will win the WYY Most Popular SuperVoice Award which will be presented in the Final Round Live Contest. The winning entries will be posted on English iZone.
- **Advancement:** The overall Top 5 First Take entries, ranked by judges will advance to the Final Round. Scores and feedback will be provided to ALL participants.
- **Final Round** (*Individual Live Contest*): Live performance will take place in the hall during lunchtime on 21 November 2025. The winners can capture the WYY SuperVoice Gold, Silver, and Bronze Mic Trophies. The winning entries will be posted on English iZone.

- Only **English songs** are allowed. The final decision will be at the discretion of the English Department.
